Please note: I am combining both Pottery I and Pottery II into one class, but to compensate, I am lengthening the class from 2 hours to 3 hours. The last hour of class is optional work time; NO NEW DEMONSTRATIONS will be shown.

Pottery I: (*Intro*) For the uninitiated wheel thrower or someone on a vacation from working with clay. Learn to center, trim, and throw as well as basic handbuilding techniques. Free out-of-class studio time available to enrolled students. Six weeks class for \$135/person. Price includes a free clay tool kit. Clay must be purchased on-site for \$14.00/bag.

Pottery II: (*Intermediate*) Emphasis on making larger vessels, vases, plate and teapots, as well as intermediate handbuilding techniques. Free out-of-class studio time available to enrolled students. Six weeks class for \$135/person. Price includes a free clay tool kit. Clay must be purchased in studio for \$14.00/bag.
